Registration - Individual - \$10.00 per person

Family - \$25.00 per family group, consisting of 2 adults plus children ages 7-18, with children 6 and under free.

Registration locations - You may register or pick up preregistration packets after 10 am on Friday, September 17, or after 9 am on Saturday, September 18, at Depot Park in Hammondsport. You may also register at the Curtiss Museum after 9 am on Saturday, September 18, or online through Wednesday, September 15.

Registration is not required if you only want to come to Depot Park to watch the seaplane activity on and above Keuka Lake.

If you pay the registration fee, which is nonrefundable, you receive

- Museum admission on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday
- Free parking & ground shuttle transportation between locations
- Boat shuttle to and from Depot Park & Champlin Beach
- Commemorative program
- Discounts at participating Hammondsport businesses
- Discounts on Seaplane Homecoming merchandise
- Eligibility to purchase tickets for Saturday night dinner
- Eligibility to purchase tickets for seaplane rides

Reservation deadline - September 13

Cancellations - Dinner reservations may be cancelled until 5 pm on Wednesday, September 15, with the exception of participating pilots, who may cancel up until 5 pm on September 16.

Seaplane Rides - Flights will be available at Depot Park in Hammondsport, but no advance reservations will be taken. Tickets will be available on Friday and Saturday on a first come, first served basis. The weather and number of participating seaplanes/pilots will determine the number of rides available. Seaplane rides on Sunday are limited.

Seaplane Ride - \$60.00 per person

Seaplane "Salute Ride" - \$100.00 per person

The salute ride flies from Hammondsport to Penn Yan and back over Glenn Curtiss's gravesite at Pleasant Valley Cemetery.

Camping Facilities - Free, but very limited, facilities are available behind the Fire Station at the South end of Keuka Lake. Regular campgrounds with facilities are also available in the area at their regular fees.

Free Parking - Available at the Curtiss Museum and at Champlin Beach. Ground shuttle transportation goes between the museum, Champlin Beach and Depot Park.
